Question

How much do Board Members of Skills Australia receive for Travel Allowance?

Answer

Skills Australia has provided the following response.

All Board Members of Skills Australia receive Tier 1 travel entitlements as determined by the Remuneration Tribunal. Tier 1 travel entitlements include allowances for travel, accommodation, meals and incidentals.

The Remuneration Tribunal Determination 2004/03: Official Travel by Office Holders, specifies the Tier 1 class of travel.

The Remuneration Tribunal Travelling Allowance Rates include accommodation, meals and incidentals per overnight absence. The travelling allowances payable to each member for overnight travel varies according to the capital city destination as specified in the determination. The rate of travel allowance payable to members is outlined in the following table:
