Question

Education measures under the Northern Territory Emergency Response

What changes have there been in the number of children per classroom (in regard to the NTER)?

Answer

Neither NTDEET nor NTCEO provide data at the classroom level.

Information from NT DEET as at 9 May 2008 shows a sustained increase in student enrolments compared with the same period in 2007. The enrolment for very remote schools in May 2008 increased by 416 students, compared to May in 2007 (10,485). See the table below for further information on enrolments in *very remote* locations (the DEET classification that includes most schools subject to NTER).
