Question

Employment programs and outcomes:

What are the employment outcomes (fulltime, part time, and none) 3 months after participating in different stages of the Job Network continuum for: sole parents and partnered parents with activity requirements on Newstart or Youth Allowance (other), sole parents and partnered parents with activity requirements on PP?

Answer

The Post-Program Monitoring (PPM) survey conducted by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) measures job seekers' outcomes three months after participation in assistance.

PPM outcomes for Sole and Partnered Parents on Newstart, Youth Allowance (other) and Parenting Payments recipients with activity requirements participating in Intensive Support job search training and Intensive Support customised assistance are shown in the table below.
