Question

Employment programs and outcomes:

What are the employment outcomes (fulltime, part time, and none) 3 months after participating in different stages of the Job Network continuum for: Newstart or Youth Allowance (other) recipients with a partial work capacity?

Answer

The Post-Program Monitoring (PPM) survey conducted by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) measures job seekers' outcomes three months after participation in assistance.

PPM outcomes for Newstart and Youth Allowance (other) recipients who had a Job Capacity Assessment completed to determine their work capacity are presented in the table below. The results relate to Intensive Support job search training and Intensive Support customised assistance.
