Answer

Safe Work Australia has provided the following response.

The Australian Safety and Compensation Council (ASCC) was an independent advisory body with representatives from the Commonwealth, State, Territories, employer and employee groups. In 2008 it approved the Office of the ASCC, a group within the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations, entering into a contract with Inkspott to provide a number of products, such as lanyards and mugs to raise awareness of occupational health and safety as part of Safe Work Australia Week, which was held in October 2008.
