## Question

Consultation with rural students about changes to YA independence criterion

Senator Hanson-Young – Could you explain what consultation was undertaken with rural students in country Australia as to the effect of these changes?

## **Answer**

The Bradley review panel conducted extensive consultations on a broad range of issues, including income support, between June and August 2008. In addition to consultations in capital cities, meetings were also held in Townsville and Albury. There were discussions about the criteria for independence.
