Background information regarding the three recent appointees to the Coal Mining Industry (Long Service Leave) Funding Corporation Board (the Board) is as follows:

- Mr Arthur Weston, the current Chair of the Board, is a former mininghuman resources manager. He was reappointed to the Board in April 2010 as a nominee of employers in the black coal mining industry. He was first appointed to the Board in April 2005.
- Mr Glenn Thompson is an Assistant National Secretary of the Australian Manufacturing Workers Union. He wasreappointed to the Board in April 2010 as a nominee of unions representing employees in the black coal mining industry. He was first appointed to the Board in January 2008.
- Mr Kieran Turner is an Executive Director for Coal Services Australia. He
