The nature of the medical condition category is as recorded for Disability Support Pension (DSP) purposes and is not necessarily reflective of the reason for which the recipient is receiving Mobility Allowance. For recipients of non-DSP payments, such as Parenting Payment and Newstart Allowance, and non-income support recipients, this information is not recorded.
