## Children in care for more than 35 hours a week

Senator NASH: I probably was not very clear there. Please provide on notice figures on how many children were in care for more than 35 hours a week. Of those in care for more than 35 hours a week, how many were at long day care and how many were at family day care? Ms Taylor: Certainly. We will do the breakdown on that.


#### Abstract

Answer Of the 963,870 children using approved child care services in the June quarter 2011, 25.3 per cent ( 244,130 children) attended child care for 35 hours or more per week. Most of the children attending for 35 hours or more per week were in Long day care ( $73.3 \%$ or 178,830 children), and one in ten ( $10.4 \%$ or 25,280 children) were using Family day care services.
