In-Home Care Places

Senator BACK: Can you tell us how many in-home care places are currently available? Ms Taylor: Currently allocated, there are 4,731. Senator BACK: Either taken up now or have been allocated to be taken up? Ms Taylor: They have been allocated to be taken up. I have a state breakdown if you wish. Senator BACK: If you give us that on notice that would be fantastic.
