Question:

Kincoppal School at Rose Bay and Vaucluse. I think it has a rating of 122 on the SES score and is an ERI 3. Can you tell me how much it received in Commonwealth grants?

Australian Government grants to Kincoppal School

Capital Grants Funding

There have been no Australian Government capital grants to Kincoppal Rose Bay School of the Sacred Heart.

General Recurrent Grants Funding

From 2001 non-systemic schools are funded having regard to the socio-economic status (SES) of their school community. Schools benefiting from SES funding get an SES funding level. Their increased funding is phased-in over 2001 to 2004 at the rate of 25% of the increase each year, so that by 2004 the schools are funded at their new SES funding level.

Yes. The school has a SES score of 122 and a funding level of 23.7% of AGSRC.
