Question:

The Department's answer to E262_04 (Senator Nettle) indicates that 64 non-government schools were audited in 2002. This covers about 2.4% of the more than 2,600 non-government schools in Australia.

- (a) Is this an adequate number? Does it meet auditing standards?
- (b) Describe the audit process? What checks are made?

Answer:

Accountability: non-government schools

- (a) Yes. The number of schools selected for the census audits complies with the principles set out in the Australian Auditing Standards.
- (b) The department selects a number of contractors to undertake the census audits. The audits include a check of staffing numbers against pay records and student numbers against enrolment and roll records at the school.
