Answer:

Review of Teaching and Teacher Education - Process

- (a) Schools visited were:
 - The Australian Science and Mathematics School, SA;
 - Salisbury High School, SA;
 - Buranda State School, Qld;
 - Calamvale Community College, Qld;
 - Redeemer Baptist School, NSW;
 - Cherrybrook Technology High School, NSW;
 - Sacred Heart Girls College, Vic;
 - Glen Waverley Secondary College, Vic;
 - Alice Springs High School, NT;
 - Centralian College, NT; and
 - Gillen Primary School, NT.

The schools were chosen on the basis of advice from school authorities, Review Committee and Reference Group members, and other organisations in a position to identify schools with particular expertise in science, technology or mathematics teaching and learning and schools successfully developing a culture of innovation in their students and community.

The schools influenced the deliberations of the Committee through their capacity and their demonstration of practical ways to enhance science, technology and mathematics teaching and learning and their innovative approaches to schooling.

(b) The Government is considering its response to the report. The form of the response is yet to be decided.
