Answer:

HECS Doubtful debt

An estimate of the amount of HECS debt unlikely to be recovered under the Government's higher education reform package, referred to as the HECS doubtful debt estimate, was prepared by the Australian Government Actuary (AGA) and included in the Cabinet submission on the reform proposals. As such, it constitutes Cabinet-in-Confidence information and can not be released.
