Question:

Please provide a breakdown of over-enrolments to be phased out by institution/state/national and type of over-enrolment (eg marginally funded and total; undergraduate and postgraduate).

Answer:

Over-enrolments

The attached table contains details of notional over-enrolments to be phased out, assuming the standard pipeline. All of the over-enrolments are marginally funded places. There is no distinction between undergraduate and postgraduate places as institutions will have some discretion in the allocation of places between undergraduate and postgraduate programs.

The table excludes the 25,000 additional places not yet allocated to individual institutions.
