- (b) When will it be finalised and come into operation?

Answer:

Supplementary learning entitlement

- (a) The Higher Education Support Bill 2003 is being amended to include provisions for "accrued Student Learning Entitlement (SLE)" to support lifelong learning. The details of this initiative are yet to be finalised.
- (b) It is expected that the details on the operation of accrued SLE will be finalised as part of the SLE Guidelines. These Guidelines will be available for sector comment in December 2003 and will come into operation on 1 January 2005.
