Senator Carr asked on 5 November 2003.

Question:

On pages 137-138 of the Annual Report are listed CSIRO actual contributions to CRCs.

Are there any instances where the actual CSIRO contribution falls short of the cash and inkind contribution committed to by CSIRO? In other words, in what cases has CSIRO's contribution fallen short?

Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

CRCs

In 5 cases CSIRO's actual 2002/03 contribution fell short of that committed due purely to timing issues:

- o Australian Petroleum CRC
- o CRC Pest Animal Control
- o CRC Innovative Dairy Products
- o CRC Tropical Plant Production
- o CRC Sustainable Aquaculture of Finfish

In all 5 cases, CSIRO will meet its commitment to the CRC over its life.

[In some cases differences in the way in which CSIRO and individual CRCs calculate in-kind contributions result in apparent (but not substantive) differences between the amounts committed and contributed to CRCs.]

Of the 46 CRCs for which CSIRO was a core partner in 2002/03, there were twelve where CSIRO's actual contribution was greater than that committed.
