### SENATE LEGISLATION COMMITTEE – QUESTIONS ON NOTICE 2003-2004 SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES HEARING

#### **DEST Question No. E581\_04**

Senator Carr asked on 5 November 2003.

#### **Question:**

Which of the consultants or organisations appointed to this panel have subsequently undertaken work for CSIRO under the preferred provider status?

What is the total amount of consulting fees paid to, or committed to, each of the panel consultants or organisations under this particular panel arrangement?

#### **Answer:**

CSIRO has provided the following response.

#### *Consultancies*

Groman Consulting and TMP / Hudson Global Resources have undertaken work for CSIRO under the leadership development and support preferred provider arrangement.

Four of the other seven consultants have been engaged by CSIRO since July 2002 but not for leadership development and support of senior managers.

The total amount of consulting fees paid to, or committed to, Groman Consulting under the preferred provider status is \$236,725. This includes \$21,650 for consulting fees for two consultancies that commenced in October 2003 (and included in the total of 14 consultancies identified in DEST Question No. E578\_04).

The total amount of consulting fees paid to, or committed to, TMP / Hudson Global Resources under the preferred provider status is \$9,625.
