## Question:

The proposed 24 new technical colleges will seemingly be stand alone colleges with specialised and narrow curriculum areas. What pathways of articulation will these colleges offer to TAFE's and universities?

## Answer:

Technical Colleges

Students in Australian Technical Colleges will work towards the existing senior secondary certificate in the relevant State/Territory and will undertake a trade School-based New Apprenticeship leading to a nationally endorsed Training Package qualification. The curriculum offered by the Colleges will be accredited with the relevant State's school authorities. Existing articulation arrangements will continue to apply.
