Question:

The Coalitions "Australians Technical Colleges" policy document on page 7 states that..."...in the case of non-government schools, no <u>additional fees</u> will be able to be charged in respect of the Australian Technical Colleges"

What does "no additional fees" mean? What would fees charged by technical colleges be in addition to?

Answer:

Technical Colleges

As with all non-government schools, Australian Technical Colleges will be required to be run on a not-for-profit basis, and no additional fees over and above existing fees will be able to be charged.

At government schools non-compulsory contributions are levied for a range of items, such as course material and field trips. These fees will continue to apply in Australian Technical Colleges. Employers may also be eligible to receive a bonus Australian Government Schoolbased Retention incentive to enable the student to complete this training.
