Question:

What is the Government's target for national R&D expenditure as a percentage of GDP?

Answer:

Research and development expenditure

The Government does not support the setting of targets for research and development (R&D) expenditure in Australia. The Government prefers to demonstrate its commitment to science and innovation through longer-term funding support. With the announcement in May 2004 of the \$5.3 billion package - Backing Australia's Ability – Building Our Future through Science and Innovation, the Government's additional investment in science and innovation will amount to \$8.3 billion over the 10 years to 2010-11. Combined with other science and innovation programmes, the Government's total commitment to science and innovation over this period totals to about \$52 billion.
