## Question:

What is gained by the reprocessing rather than storing them unprocessed at Lucas Heights?

## Answer:

Unreprocessed and Reprocessed Spent Fuels

As has been on the public record since the publication of the Draft EIS for the OPAL reactor in 1998, unreprocessed aluminium-clad fuel such as that from the HIFAR reactor is prone to corrosion over time. Reprocessing of spent fuel results in the production of a highly stable waste form suitable for long term storage and eventual disposal.
