##### *Baseline Indicators for the Murdi Paaki COAG Trial*

Consistent with the reporting requirements of the Council of Australian Governments (COAG) Whole of Government Indigenous initiative, a Murdi Paaki Monitoring and Evaluation Framework has been developed and agreed to by trial partners to progress the collection and analysis of baseline data for the Murdi Paaki region.
