Answer:

School broadband Internet access

The Australian Government funds a range of programmes providing Information and Communication Technology (ICT) support to schools. These initiatives support and encourage access to, and use of ICT and digital resources across school systems in the States and Territories. However, decisions about the level of the provision of Internet access at an individual school are the matter for individual schools and their relevant education authority within the State or Territory. Accordingly, the Australian Government does not hold information on this aspect of individual schools in each jurisdiction.
