#### **Answer:**

*Investing in Our Schools – unsuccessful government schools by electorate*

In making applications for IOSP funding we do not consider that schools would reasonably expect that details of their unsuccessful applications would be made public. On this basis it would be inappropriate to publicly disclose details of unsuccessful applications. Such disclosure may have an adverse affect on schools' standing and reputation in their local communities. Aggregate figures have been provided for each electorate on unsuccessful grants for Round One. No grants have yet been considered for government schools in Round Two.
