Does DEST believe that there are no land rights or native title issues over the three sites? What basis does DEST have for it's assertions? Please provide details of any investigations or legal advice undertaken to verify this.

Answer:

Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Facility

The Department has taken expert advice on these issues. The Commonwealth asserts that native title does not exist over the three Defence sites in the Northern Territory identified for further investigation for a Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Facility, by virtue of the freehold interest in the land held by the Commonwealth.

There are no native title claims over any of the sites. The Native Title Tribunal can confirm this.
