The Minister wrote to the Central and Northern Land Council advising them of the Government's decision to establish the Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Facility on 15 July 2005. There was subsequent correspondence on 26 October 2005, 8 November 2005 and 16 November 2005 (Central Land Council) and 17 August 2005, 5 October 2005, 3 November and 6 November 2005 (Northern Land Council).
