Question:

What are the Minister's forecasts for unmet demand for student enrolments in Universities throughout Australia for each year from 2005 to 2010, or for years for which forecasts are available?

Forecasts for unmet demand for students enrolments in Universities

Estimates for unmet demand for undergraduate places in Universities are produced by the Australian Vice-Chancellors' Committee (AVCC). The AVCC releases these estimates around May each year.¹

The AVCC does not publish forecasts of unmet demand. However, the AVCC 2005 Report on Applications for Undergraduate University Courses has published estimates of unmet demand for 2005, which is detailed at the answer to DEST Question No. 656_06.
