Higher Education Enrolments

In relation to Commonwealth supported places, the Government funds higher education providers on the basis of funding agreements that are negotiated annually and for extra places yet to be allocated. The Department is currently finalising 2006 Funding Agreements and these will be tabled in Parliament when they are finalised. Therefore, it is not possible to provide data for Budget out years. Enrolment data is collected annually by the Department and relates to calendar years. Therefore it is not possible to provide this information for Budget out years.
