#### Question:

What is the final funding allocation for LTPF for 2006 by university? Please provide a breakdown of the allocation for each university, including the base grant given to all providers and the additional amount distributed based on Equivalent Full-time Student Load.

#### Answer:

##### *Learning and Teaching Performance Fund*

The final funding allocations for the Learning and Teaching Performance Fund for 2006 were announced by the Minister on 29 November 2005.

The following providers, stated in alphabetical order, will share approximately \$30 million in additional funding for best demonstrating excellence in teaching and learning. The funding has been calculated on the basis of a \$1 million base grant, and a further amount calculated on the basis of the provider's undergraduate student load (*Equivalent Full Time Student Load for bachelor students*):
