## Question:

- (a) The latest Annual report breaks down 'Sales of goods & services' into 'Sales of goods & services external entities' and 'Sales of goods & services related entities'. What are the definitions of 'external' and 'related' entities?
- (b) Please provide a breakdown of each organisation included in each category, including the amount of sales to each. Please list these since 2000.
- (c) How does CSIRO explain a \$52 million drop in revenue from external entities?

## Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Sales of goods and services

- (a) The definition of 'related entities' covers all statutory bodies and their trading entities covered by the *Commonwealth Authorities and Companies Act 1997* as well as agencies covered by the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 199*, according to a list from the *Department of Finance and Administration*. 'External entities' are all other organisations that are not 'related entities'.
- (b) CSIRO data is not held in this aggregated.
- (c) In 2004/05, CSIRO conducted a review of its related party disclosure note to include <u>all</u> 'related entities' revenues, rather than just the revenue from <u>material</u> related entity customers. Due to the use of different criterion for the classification of revenue figures in 2005 as compared to 2004, between-year comparisons are not "like-for-like" comparisons, for each of the 'related entity' and 'external entities' categories.
