Hospitality Expenditure

In CSIRO expenditure on entertainment and hospitality may be incurred in circumstances aimed at advancing the work of the organisation. In general CSIRO's expenditure on entertainment and hospitality includes expenditure on public events such as launches, openings and other functions, catering for advisory and review committees, catering for conferences and seminars, meetings with clients and stakeholders, hosting overseas visitors and the like.
