Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 146: Who does the department intend to consult with in relation to the changes to the JSCI to take into account the new cohort?

#### **Answer:**

The Department has consulted with the Centrelink Participation Community Reference Group about the development of the JSCI to be implemented from early July 2006.
