Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 13:

Can the department please advise what it determines are serious issues regarding contractual breaches with Job Network members?

Answer:

The Department gives careful consideration to all matters that come to its attention, whether through contract monitoring or as a result of other advice, that might involve a breach of the contract.

In determining the seriousness of a possible breach the Department has regard to such matters as

- the impact on job seekers
- financial materiality
- whether an incident is isolated or part of a more systemic pattern of conduct
- whether there was an intent to breach the contract or commit fraud
- whether the matters can be remedied.

The Department seeks, whose possible, that such matters are remedied and may, in serious cases, sanction providers for breaching the contract.
