#### **Question:**

Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* at page 43:

Could the OEA provide the survey sample size used for the OEA's employer survey in 2000?

#### Answer:

In total there were 688 useable responses out of 2,000 questionnaires<sup>1</sup>. This provided a response rate just over 34 per cent<sup>2</sup>.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> These 2,000 questionnaires were sent out on 16-5-2000. All responses were coded up until 22-6-2000. A further 213 employers with AWAs did not receive questionnaires due to administration irregularities and insufficient contact data.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> This response rate compares favourably with other recent workplace and organisational based mailout surveys (Wooden, 1999; Brosnan & Walsh, 1998; Wooden & VandenHeuvel, 1996).
