## **Question:**

Senator Marshall asked in writing:

How many apprentices/trainees are on AWAs? What age are these apprentices/trainees?

#### **Answer:**

The OEA measure of AWA coverage is an estimate of number of AWAs currently in operation. This estimate is arrived at by using the number of AWAs approved over the last 3 years.

Total AWAs approved for apprentice/trainees in the last 3 years (Nov 2002 - Oct 2005). The last column is a percentage of the total number of AWAs approved during that time period.
