Enforcement and Monitoring Activities under the ESOS Act 2000

From 11 May 2006 (the date to which the last update was provided to Committee members) until 31 October 2006, there have been **92 monitoring and enforcement actions** exercising the powers of the ESOS Act. These details are at Attachment A.

Sanctions imposed under the ESOS Act

From 11 May 2006 (the date to which the last update was provided to Committee members) until 31 October 2006, **4 enforcement sanctions** (one cancellation and three suspensions) have been imposed. These details are at <u>Attachment B.</u>

Combined Commonwealth and State conditions, suspensions and cancellations

From 11 May 2006 (the date to which the last update was provided to Committee members) until 31 October 2006, the combined Commonwealth and State/Territory conditions, suspensions and cancellation of providers, totals action on **43 providers**. These details are provided in Attachment C.. Providers may be suspended or cancelled by State and Territory authorities for a variety of reasons.
