#### Answer:

Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Facility – joint regulatory processes

The Department of the Environment and Heritage has provided the following response:

The Department of the Environment and Heritage (DEH) and the Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Agency (ARPANSA) have agreed to a joint process for the purposes of both environmental impact assessment under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* and the possible granting of licences under the *Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety* Act 1998. There have been discussions between DEH and ARPANSA on how best to streamline the assessment and approval processes once a site is selected although, to date, no agreement or memorandum of understanding has been completed to formalise assessment and approval procedures between the respective agencies.
