## Question:

- a. The Indigenous Education (Targeted Assistance) Act 2005 transferred some \$10.9 million funds from IESIP where it was quarantined for Indigenous institutions, to the Commonwealth State Training Fund Agreement under the Skilling Australia's Workforce Act 2005. This had potential disadvantages in terms of funding to 4 independent Indigenous education institutes. Can you give me a breakdown of total Commonwealth funding provided to each of the 4 following independent Indigenous education institutions for 2004, 2005 and 2006, the four being Tranby College; Institute for Aboriginal Development; Aboriginal Dance Theatre and Tauondi College in Adelaide?
- b. From which program(s) did this funding come?
- c. Can you also provide details of when funds released were made to each in 2006, and the amounts on each occasion?
- d. Tranby report no funds released until May 2006. Why was this delay?

## Answer:

Transitional Funding

a. The following table provides a breakdown of the Commonwealth funding provided to each of the four independent Indigenous education institutions for 2004, 2005 and 2006.
