Proposed RQF Models

The Department of Education, Science and Training (DEST) has received feedback and correspondence from universities regarding the proposed RQF models in the form of email, fax and post. Feedback received in regard to the *RQF Issues Paper*, *Preferred Model* and the *Final Advice*, which has been authorised for publication, can be found on the DEST website at: http://www.dest.gov.au/research/rgf.

Themes include, for example, interest in:

- a) The measurement of impact;
- b) Attribution and cut off date for research to be included in the RQF:
- c) Funding implications;
- d) Possible administration burden; and
- e) Assessment of cross-disciplinary research and the effect on collaborative research behaviour.

University cohort groups are generally supportive of the RQF process and a new research funding scheme for Australia.
