## Question:

- (a) At what stage is DEST in the development of a single national proposal for NCRIS funding?
- (b) Has a single proposal been developed yet?
- (c) When is it expected to be finalised?
- (d) When will it be approved by the Minster?
- (e) When will it be made public?

## Answer:

NCRIS single national proposal

(a), (b) and (c) The NCRIS Roadmap indicates that "the Government intends that a single national, collaborative proposal (incorporating a business plan) be developed to address each area of capability".
