Delivery of CDEP in the Pukatja Community

Can you please confirm that there is currently no waste management of garbage collection services in Pukatja as a result of the decision to transfer the CDEP contract to AP Services?

**Answer:**

Waste management services, including garbage collection, forms part of the Municipal Services programme administered by the Department of Families, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs. DEWR understands waste management services are being delivered in the Pukatja Community, albeit via a different service provider (that is, AP Services) and that a small number of CDEP participants from the Anilalya Homelands CDEP programme are assisting AP Services in this service delivery.
