#### **Question:**

Senator Wong gave the following question on notice:

<u>Compliance</u>: for participation failures that resulted in a suspension of payment for 8 weeks, how many participation failures were a result of (a) three participation failures in 12 months? (b) someone becoming unemployed voluntarily? (c) dismissal due to misconduct? (d) refusal to accept a suitable job offer? (e) failure to commence, complete or participate in, or comply with the conditions of, an approved programme of work?

#### **Answer:**

From 1 July 2006 to 17 November 2006 3,765 job seekers had an 8 week non payment period applied by Centrelink as a result of a serious failure or repeated participation failure.
