Senator Lundy asked at *Hansard* page 48 and 49:

Of those restaurants that have recently found to be in breach of the minimum standards – Why have you chose not to name the restaurants and will you name them now? Please provide a full list of those restaurants which have breached conditions and those which have not.

**Answer:**

OWS does not propose to provide a list of restaurants that have been the subject of OWS audits. Where investigations are ongoing, disclosing the list is likely to prejudice the ongoing investigation. Where investigations are complete and resulted in litigation, the details of the alleged breaches are the subject of court action.
