Were the difficulties identified by the ART considered by DEWR when it was setting the timeframes for the ART's review and reporting on wage and classification structures? If not, why not, given one of the most common criticisms of the Award system is its duplication, complexity and uncertainty?

Answer:

The Government's decision to establish the Award Review Taskforce (the Taskforce) reflected its concern about the duplication and complexity of the award system. The Taskforce's findings clearly demonstrate that and the need for rationalisation in this area.
