Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Federal Magistrates Services (FMS) Collective</u> <u>Agreement Negotiation</u> Explain how it is possible to cut and paste an entire draft agreement, provide a pay increase and put it out as an AWA with identical content reflected for all staff when the same detail cannot be reflected in the collective agreement.

Answer:

All workplace agreements entered into by Australian Public Service (APS) agencies are subject to the same policy requirements, namely the Policy Parameters for Agreement Making in the APS.
