### Question:

Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Work Choices Implementation Agencies –</u> <u>Workplace Advisory Service</u> If not, what other functions does the WAS have – either alone, with the OEA or other Agencies?

### Answer:

The Workplace Advisory Service performs a range of functions including:

- attending and/or organising speaking engagements, expositions and events;
- visiting employer, employee, industry and community groups to provide education and advice on workplace relations;
- proactively monitoring the environment to identify and address gaps in workplace relations education activities;
- contributing to WorkChoices product development; and
- assisting in the evaluation of contractors providing services under the Employer Advisor Programme, the National Advisor Network Programme and the Working Women's Centres.
