Departmental Workplace Advisors from the Workplace Advisory Service visit a range of organisations to ensure these groups have the support and assistance needed to educate their members and clients about WorkChoices.

Organisations include those catering for small business, women, youth, multicultural, indigenous and disabled client groups. Services offered by the Workplace Advisory Service include attendance at speaking engagements, provision of WorkChoices information products and ongoing technical support and assistance.
