### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing:

<u>Work Choices Implementation Agencies - Alternative Dispute Resolution Assistance</u> Scheme.

Can a multi-million dollar company such as Telstra apply for assistance from ADRAS?

#### **Answer:**

Yes. Under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*, employers and employees have a choice between referring certain disputes to a private alternative dispute resolution provider or the Australian Industrial Relations Commission for assistance. The intent of ADRAS is to facilitate genuine choice in dispute resolution.
