Senator Crossin asked in writing:

How were AILC selected to provide leadership training for people in Alice Springs?
Was there no potential local RTO (such as IAD or CDU?) that could teach Certificate IV level work? Were such local providers invited to bid for teaching this course?

Answer:

The selection was based on a review of potential providers that could deliver accredited Indigenous leadership training on a national basis with consideration given to organisations that had a proven track record of providing leadership training to Indigenous Australians.
